

EYPP Planning for 2019-2020

We have 18 children who are eligible for pupil premium funding for the autumn term, this would equate to approximately £5400 for the year. We anticipate this figure will raise significantly over the year, as more children become eligible each term, therefore we are planning to spend approximately £8000, in line with last year's allocation. This planning will be adapted when we have the confirmed list of eligible children, each term.
